

PRESERVES/TRAILS/PARKS

Crest is extremely fortunate to have nature preserves surrounding our community.

Crestridge Ecological Reserve - https://wildlife.ca.gov/Lands/Places-to-Visit/Crestridge-ER: At the top of the hill buy the chalkboard, turn on to Mountain View, then turn left on Horsemill Road and enter the reserve at the end of the cul-de-sac. A visitor kiosk will provide maps and pamphlets with information. Multi-use trails for hikers, bicycles, horseback riding. No motorized vehicles allowed.

South Lane Park-
